Cubbies

Please remember to clean out your child's cubby at the end of every day, some of the cubbies are getting quite full, and the children are having trouble stowing their new art creations.

Warm Weather

We will be going outside in all kinds of weather! Make sure your child has **boots (for mud)** available for use every day. We will go out in rain if it is sprinkling, please send extra socks to keep in the cubby in case socks get wet. It also may be a good idea to send layers for recess since the weather is unpredictable. Please check those spare clothes in the cubbies to be sure they are season appropriate as the weather warms.

Water Bottles in Cubbies

Having a water bottle in each child's cubby is working out wonderfully, please continue to make sure your child has one in their cubby each day.

Maker space

Please continue to bring: toilet paper/paper towel tubes, small containers like rinsed out and clean yogurt or applesauce containers (or other containers of similar size), lids (they make great wheels), only small plastic lids please, like you would find on water, milk or gatorade, or any other item you think may inspire creativity, as long as it is small enough to fit on a shelf for our maker space. The children's creations are becoming more complex, it is so cool to see their imaginations at work!! I am trying to be diligent about taking pictures to hang on the wall behind the books, check it out!
